

## Check the account balance


You can check that the Peercoins are still at the Public Address by visiting <https://explorer.peercoin.net/> and entering the Public Address in the search bar:

You can use your Peercoins (e.g. send them to a friend or family member) by downloading the Peercoin Wallet software from <https://peercoin.net/download> and importing your Private Key by selecting **Help > Debug window > Console** and entering the command `importprivkey <Private Key>`:
